

Synergy Billing CEO to speak at 1 Million Cups forum

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DAYTONA BEACH - Jayson Meyer, CEO of Synergy Billing, will be the presenter at this week's 1 Million Cups entrepreneurs' forum in downtown Daytona Beach.

The Daytona Beach provider of medical billing services to community health centers across the country was founded by Meyer in 2006. Synergy Billing was the recipient of a Florida Job Creators award from Gov. Rick Scott in August and was recently named to Inc. magazine's list of the nation's 5,000 fastest-growing private companies and the Florida Economic Gardening Institute/GrowFL's list of 50 Florida Companies to Watch.

Synergy Billing recently got the go-ahead from Holly Hill to buy a portion of the former Holly Hill Middle School property along Center Street just north of LPGA Boulevard. The company plans to build an office park called The Fountainhead there that will include a medical billing academy, a restaurant, child-care center, apartments and other amenities for its employees.

Meyer is also involved in the Startup Weekend event at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University on Nov. 13-15, a 54-hour crash course on how to create a startup business. Details on the event can be found at daytonabeach.up.co/events/7047.
